Since winning the Red Dot Design and House Beautiful Awards recently, Jotul launches new finishes for the popular F163 wood burning stoves; **white enamel and black enamel**. The F163 small stove with curved shaped back is ideally suited for corners and flat walls. The stoves are user friendly with only one vent to control both the lighting and primary air to help maintain correct combustion for reduced consumption of wood with clean burn. There is also an option to add an outside air connection. The side glass has a special surface treatment to leave them free of soot. Jotul pioneered the porcelain enamelling process for stoves over 50 years ago. Its' durable, medium-gloss, porcelain enamel finish is the best and the most beautiful - highlighting the stoves textured and smooth surfaces.

Today, Jotul produce enamel finishes with differing degrees of lustre, some are matt, others glossier and some majolica enamel. They all have in common durability and maintenance-free qualities to last for several generations. The newly introduced F163 are satin black enamel and silk white enamel.
